**SUBJECT: Local Capital Improvement Revenue for Eligible Charter Schools**

Section 31 of [chapter 2017-116, Laws of Florida \(House Bill 7069\)](#), codified in section 1013.62, Florida Statutes, (F.S.), requires school districts to distribute to eligible charter schools, by February 1, 2018, local capital improvement revenue (LCIR) from the discretionary millage authorized in section 1011.71(2), F.S. Attached is a district-level summary and a summary by charter school of the distribution amounts, as calculated by the Florida Department of Education.

Please note that each school district's LCIR revenue has been reduced by its annual debt service obligation incurred as of March 1, 2017, and paid during the 2017-18 fiscal year from LCIR funds, and by its Special Facility Construction Program participation requirement, if applicable.

Each charter school's distribution amount has been reduced by the state funds allocated for charter school capital outlay, pursuant to section 1013.62(2), F.S., if applicable.
